NOTICE OF PROPERTY TAX INCREASE

The Miller County Board of Commissioners has tentatively adopted a millage rate which will require an increase in property taxes by .49 percent. All concerned citizens are invited to the public hearing on this tax increase to be held at the Miller County Courthouse Annex, 179 S. Cuthbert Street, on **September 18th, 2020 at 9 am and 6: 30 pm.** Times and places of additional public hearings on this tax increase are at Miller County Courthouse Annex, 179 S. Cuthbert Street, on **September 25, 2020 at 9:30 am.** This tentative increase will result in a millage rate of 16.560 mills and increase of .0081 mills. Without this tentative tax increase, the millage rate will be no more than 16.479 mills. The proposed tax increase for a home with a fair market value of \$100,000 is approximately \$32.40 and the proposed tax increase for non-homestead property with a fair market value of \$300,000 is approximately \$97.20

Miller County Board of Commissioners is adopting the Millage without the rollback. The Millage will remain the same as 2019 at 16.560
